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4 **ORDINANCE 2019-502-E**

5 AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CALENDAR YEAR 2019 ANNUAL  
6 TAXES ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN  
7 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INCLUDING ONLY URBAN  
8 SERVICES DISTRICTS TWO, THREE, AND FOUR, TO  
9 WIT: THE CITIES OF ATLANTIC BEACH, NEPTUNE  
10 BEACH AND JACKSONVILLE BEACH; STATING THE  
11 PERCENTAGE INCREASE FROM THE 2019 ROLLED-BACK  
12 RATE; AUTHORIZING ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION;  
13 PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE REVENUES  
14 GENERATED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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16 **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville entered into interlocal  
17 agreements with the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach  
18 and Neptune Beach in 1995, 1996 & 1998, respectively, which  
19 established the millage rates as the difference between the City of  
20 Jacksonville's General Services District's millage rate and 3.2907  
21 mills; and

22 **WHEREAS**, this ordinance establishes the millage rates for the  
23 cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach and Neptune Beach in  
24 accordance with the interlocal agreements and Chapter 200, Florida  
25 Statutes; now therefore

26 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

27 **Section 1. Ad valorem tax levy - General Services**  
28 **District, including only Urban Service Districts 2, 3, and 4 (The**  
29 **Beaches).** In accordance with Chapter 200, Florida Statutes, and  
30 the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and the  
31 cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach and Neptune Beach, for

1 the year 2019, there are hereby levied upon all taxable real and  
2 personal property located within the General Services District of  
3 the city, including only the Second, Third, and Fourth Urban  
4 Services Districts (the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville  
5 Beach and Neptune Beach), for county purposes, ad valorem taxes  
6 expressed in terms of mills on each dollar of assessed taxable  
7 valuation in the amount of 8.1512 mills, or \$8.1512 per \$1,000  
8 assessed taxable value.

9 **Section 2. Percentage increase from the rolled-back rate.**

10 The 2019 operating millage rate levied herein by the Consolidated  
11 City of Jacksonville upon property within the General Services  
12 District of the city, including only the Second, Third, and Fourth  
13 Urban Services Districts, represents a 5.56% increase from the 2019  
14 rolled-back rate set forth in Resolution 2019-500-A; which is the  
15 amount agreed upon in the Interlocal Agreement between the City of  
16 Jacksonville and the cities of Atlantic Beach, Jacksonville Beach  
17 and Neptune Beach.

18 **Section 3. Assessment and collection.** The Property

19 Appraiser of the county is authorized and directed to assess, and  
20 the Tax Collector of the County is authorized and directed to  
21 collect, pursuant to law, the ad valorem taxes levied in this  
22 ordinance.

23 **Section 4. Use of revenues.** The revenues raised by the

24 ad valorem taxes levied in this ordinance shall be utilized in the  
25 manner and for the purposes specified in the 2019-2020 budget and  
26 appropriations ordinance.

27 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

28 effective upon signature by the Council President.
