**Re: Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Fund – Ordinance 2026-\_\_\_\_\_**

Dear Tim:

As requested, we have reviewed Ordinance 2026- (TBD) which amends Section 121.105 of the City Ordinance (the benefit provisions of the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Fund, or PFPF) to add two new job titles to the list of jobs exempt for retirees to be employed by the City with no pension benefit consequences (namely, sworn civil process server and Sheriff’s liaison officer). Retirees of the Jacksonville PFPF employed in any of the exempt jobs listed in Section 121.105 (including these two additional job titles) shall be excluded from the following provisions of the pension fund: (1) the requirement that pension benefits cease during the period of reemployment; and (2) the requirement to re-enter the pension fund, make employee contributions to the fund, and be eligible to accrue time-service credit. Such re-employed pensioner retirees will continue to be treated as retirees of the PFPF. They will continue to receive retirement benefits during the period of reemployment and shall accrue no additional benefits.

**In our opinion, this ordinance will not have an actuarial impact on the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Fund for advance funding purposes.** Because this change will not have an actuarial impact on the cost of the Retirement System, it is our opinion that a formal Actuarial Impact Statement is not required. However, we recommend that you send a copy of this letter and the ordinance to the Bureau of Local Retirement Systems.
