Bill Summary: This bill amends Sections 462.106, 462.201, 462.203, 462.204, 462.205, 462.209, 462.210, 462.301, 462.302, 462.303, 462.304, 462.305, and 462.601, *Ordinance Code*

Background Information: This bill amends Section 462.106, *Ordinance Code*, to clarify standards for issuance of citations. It also amends Sections 462.201, 462.203-205, 462.209-210, *Ordinance Code*, to revise and clarify provisions related to cruelty, neglect, abandonment, and tethering of animals, to specify that animal fighting activities constitute animal cruelty, and to align the Code with the required timelines and procedures for animal custody petitions outlined in Section 828.073, *Florida Statutes*. The bill amends Sections 462.301-305 of the *Ordinance Code* to simplify the language and clarify the standards for issuing citations. It amends Section 462.601, *Ordinance Code*, to reduce the required "stray hold" period from six days to three days.
