Bill Summary: The bill reschedules the agenda meeting and the standing committee meeting of the Land Use and Zoning Committee from Tuesday, May 16, 2023, to Wednesday, May 17, 2023. It directs the Legislative Services Division to ensure that all public hearings and other notifications are advertised and scheduled for May 17. The bill waives Council Rule 2.201 to authorize the rescheduling of the meeting to an alternate date. Emergency passage upon introduction is requested.

Background Information: The bill will reschedule the LUZ Committee meeting of May 16th to the following day to avoid the meeting conflicting with the 2023 Unitary General Election. Council Rule 2.201 is waived to permit the meeting to be held on a day other than the first and third Tuesdays of the month designated by the Council President as the established meeting date for the committee during the current council year. Emergency passage upon introduction is requested to ensure that City staff has time to prepare and issue revised notices and advertisements for these hearings to provide as much advance notice to the public as possible.
