5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$7,656.00 PROJECT
6 AWARD THROUGH THE NORTHEAST FLORIDA HEALTHCARE
7 COALITION (NEFLHCC), WITH NO LOCAL MATCH, TO
8 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE INITIAL PURCHASE OF
9 STOP THE BLEED KITS, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 20-
10 036; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR
11 HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO
12 EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE
13 CITY, THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
14 NORTHEAST FLORIDA REGIONAL COUNCIL AND CITY OF
15 JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE
16 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT;
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
21 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
22 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
23 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

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30 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

31 The appropriation above is a Project award through the

1 Northeast Florida Healthcare Coalition (NEFLHCC) for the
2 purchase of 200 bleeding control kits. The NEFLHCC award
3 is a "reimbursement" award, which requires initial
4 purchase of the bleeding control kits by the Jacksonville
5 Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD), followed by 100%
6 reimbursement of the costs up to the award amount of
7 \$7,656.00 by NEFLHCC. There is no City match.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
9 Section 1 is to provide funding for the initial purchase of Stop
10 the Bleed Kits. Uncontrolled bleeding is the number one cause of
11 preventable traumatic death. The bleeding control kits contain
12 essential life-saving equipment necessary in the event of a large
13 scale Mass Casualty Incident.

14 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
15 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
16 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of
17 the City, the Memorandum of Agreement between the Northeast Florida
18 Regional Council and City of Jacksonville, a copy of which is
19 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
20 reference (the "MOA"). Pursuant to the MOA, the bleeding control
21 kits must be purchased and received by JFRD no later than May 1,
22 2020, in order to receive reimbursement from the Northeast Florida
23 Regional Council.

24 **Section 4. Oversight.** JFRD shall oversee the project
25 described herein.

26 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
27 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
28 without the Mayor's signature.
