Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Tatiana Yoguez, a Clay County resident with significant business interest in Duval County, as a member of the Sex Trafficking Survivors Leadership Council, for a first full term ending May 31, 2024.

Background Information: The Sex Trafficking Survivors Leadership Council is established pursuant to Chapter 96, *Ordinance Code*, and it is an advisory body to the City Council to investigate the root causes of sex trafficking in the City and to develop effective measures to prevent sex trafficking, enhance public awareness of both the problems associated with sex trafficking and to recognize the characteristics of the sex trafficking trade and to advise the Council on potential policies and programs to further the City's goal of eliminating the sex trafficking trade in the City. Section 96.103, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Survivors Council shall be composed of seven members selected by the Mayor and approved by the City Council.

Ms. Yoguez works for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office in the Special Assault Unit providing training to police officers on victim advocacy for human trafficking victims. Ms. Yoguez currently works for the Delores Barr Weaver Policy Center developing connections with individuals receiving services. Ms. Yoguez resides in Clay County.
