Bill Summary: This bill confirms the appointment of Kirsten Doolittle to the Cultural Service Grant Committee, replacing Sel Buyuksarac as a Cultural Council Board representative, for a first term ending December 31, 2024.

Background Information: The Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, Ordinance Code, and charged to recommend to the Cultural Council Board of Directors the organizations to be funded and the amount of the funding. Section 118.605, Ordinance Code, provides that the membership of the committee shall include seven individuals selected from a community wide nominating process and confirmed by the City Council.

Ms. Doolittle is currently the Managing Shareholder at Aequitas Counsel. She has a Juris Doctorate from the University of Southern California. She ran and operated the Law Office of Kirsten Doolittle from 2006 to 2018.

Ms. Doolittle resides in Duval County.
