Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$500,000 from the State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity through the Florida Defense Support Task Force and administered by Enterprise Florida, Inc. The bill authorizes the Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Enterprise Florida, Inc. for the Florida Defense Support Task Force. The Military Affairs and Veterans Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the City's Encroachment Protection/Compatible Land Use Program, a partnership with the US Navy to protect naval bases and airfields in Duval County from encroachment by incompatible land uses and development within the Military Influence Zones through the procurement of restrictive use easements. This appropriation, with other Department of Defense funds, will be utilized to purchase additional restrictive use easements on properties surrounding NS Mayport, NAS Jacksonville and OLF Whitehouse to secure Duval County's Navy bases and airfields from encroachment and to minimize community concerns regarding aircraft traffic and noise.
