ORDINANCE 2024-377-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 CITY GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND CLARA WHITE MISSION, INC. (THE "AGREEMENT"), TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE AGREEMENT TO EXPIRE ON FEBRUARY 28, 2025 AND EXTENDING CERTAIN OTHER RELATED DATES AND DEADLINES WITHIN THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY ORDINANCE 2023-608-E TO FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2023-608-E appropriated \$300,000 and authorized the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, to execute, on behalf of the City, a grant agreement between the City and Clara White Mission, Inc. ("Clara White"), for the White Harvest Farms Culinary Vocational Training Program (the "Program"); and

WHEREAS, the term of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 City Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Clara White Mission, Inc. (the "Agreement") is currently set to expire on September 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Clara White has requested an extension to the term of the Agreement to accommodate the additional time it took to fully set up the Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council therefore desires to extend the term of the Agreement to February 28, 2025, and to carryover the funds set aside to fund the Program, to fiscal year 2024-2025; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Amendment to Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain First Amendment to the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 City Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Clara White Mission, Inc., in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, to extend the term of the Agreement to February 28, 2025, in addition to an extension of related dates for submittal of reimbursement requests and documentation, and deadlines to request budget amendments and quarterly reports, with all other terms and conditions of the Agreement remaining unchanged.

Section 2. Carryover. The funds appropriated pursuant to Ordinance 2023-608-E to fund the White Harvest Farms Culinary Vocational Training Program remaining at the end of fiscal year 2023-2024 shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 4. Oversight. The Grants and Contract Compliance
Division of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
continue to have oversight of the Agreement described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
