RESOLUTION 2025-231-A

A RESOLUTION HONORING JASON R. TEAL ON DEDICATED CAREER IN THE OFFICE OF GENERAL RECOGNIZING HIS COUNSEL AND 2.4 YEARS OF EFFECTIVE AND EXEMPLARY SERVICE TO THE CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jason R. Teal earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Environmental Science from the University of Kansas in 1992 and his Juris Doctorate (with honors) from the Florida State University College of Law in 1998; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Teal began his law practice at The Walters Law Firm in Jacksonville where he handled a variety of environmental matters, including environmental due diligence reviews related to real estate transactions and negotiating various regulatory permits, consent orders and remedial corrective action plans with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, before joining the Office of General Counsel in 2000; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Teal joined the Office of General Counsel as an Assistant General Counsel and continued in that role for ten years at which point he was promoted to Chief of the Regulatory Division; in 2015 he was promoted to Deputy General Counsel with responsibility for oversight and management of the Regulatory and Constitutional Law Department; and

WHEREAS, in 2021 Mr. Teal was recommended by Mayor Lenny Curry for appointment to the position of General Counsel of the Consolidated

Government of the City of Jacksonville, which appointment was confirmed by the City Council in August of 2021, and he served as General Counsel until June of 2023; and

WHEREAS, after serving as General Counsel, Mr. Teal remained with the Office of General Counsel and served both as Senior Assistant General Counsel, offering wisdom, insight and assistance during a time of significant transition for the Office of General Counsel; he has most recently served as Deputy General Counsel over the reconstituted Regulatory and Constitutional Law Department since January of 2024; and

WHEREAS, throughout his tenure with the Office of General Counsel, Mr. Teal provided dedicated legal counsel to the City and its independent agencies and represented the Consolidated Government in a variety of substantive areas of law; he has been particularly effective in providing guidance and counsel on matters of public policy and litigation strategy and has zealously advocated for the best interests of his individual clients and the Consolidated Government as a whole; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Teal has recently accepted the opportunity to continue his service to the City of Jacksonville in a new role as the Council Secretary/Director; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Jason R. Teal for 24 years of dedicated and effective service to the City of Jacksonville in the Office of General Counsel where he diligently and successfully represented the Consolidated Government's interests in a myriad of legal proceedings, involving all manner of legal concepts of varying depth and complexity.
