AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$310,713.50 FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY TO THE MENTAL HEALTH OFFENDER PROGRAM ("MHOP") TO PAY FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES BY I.M. SULZBACHER CENTER FOR THE HOMELESS, INC. ("SULZBACHER") FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF A JAIL DIVERSION PROGRAM FOR MENTALLY ILL OFFENDERS THROUGH THE MHOP; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2025; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND I.M. SULZBACHER CENTER FOR THE HOMELESS, INC. FOR THE PROVISION SERVICES FOR THE MHOP; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH SULZBACHER; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION; GRANTS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(C) Explanation of Appropriation:

> funding above represents an appropriation \$310,713.50 from the Council President's Designated Contingency to procure contractual services from I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. ("Sulzbacher") for the continued operation of a jail diversion program for mentally ill offenders through the Mental Health Offender Program ("MHOP").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide City funds to procure contractual services from I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. for the continued operation of a jail diversion program for mentally ill offenders through the Mental Health Offender Program.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to September 30, 2025.

Section 4. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, a Services Contract between the City of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., subject to the terms, conditions and budget outlined in Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Term Sheet, July 15, 2024 - NCSPHS" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$310,713.50

for a term commencing on July 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025, for the continued provision of services for the Mental Health Offender Program, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 5. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code, to Allow for a Direct Contract with I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract between I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., and the City of Jacksonville for Sulzbacher's continued oversight and management of the jail diversion program for mentally ill offenders through the MHOP. This waiver is justified because Sulzbacher has successfully operated the jail diversion program since the inception of the MHOP as a nine-month pilot project.

Section 6. Oversight. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
