AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$25,000 FROM GENERAL FUND OPERATING RESERVES TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING, MISCELLANEOUS GRANTS AND AIDS ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE CITY GRANT FUNDING TO THE DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED ("MLK FOUNDATION") TO SUPPORT THE 2025 MLK HOLIDAY GRAND PARADE EVENT AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH MLK FOUNDATION; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH MLK FOUNDATION; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. MEMORIAL FOUNDATION, INCORPORATED FOR THE 2025 MLK HOLIDAY GRAND PARADE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

1 2 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 3 Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, Section 1. 4 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 5 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b): 6 7 (The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference) 8 9 (a) Appropriated from: \$25,000 10 See Exhibit 1 Appropriated to: 11 (b) See Exhibit 1 \$25,000 12 13 (C) Explanation of Appropriation: The funding above is an appropriation of \$25,000 from 14 General Fund Operating Reserves to the General Fund 15 Operating, Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account to provide 16 17 a grant to The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Foundation, Incorporated ("MLK Foundation") to provide 18 City funds for certain costs and expenses related to the 19 20 2025 MLK Holiday Grand Parade in Jacksonville. Although 21 the funds appropriated herein are from General Fund 22 Operating Reserves, the proposed use of these funds to 23 support programs and initiatives in Council District 9 24 fulfills the intent for funds previously appropriated in 25 fiscal year 2023-2024 for Council District 9 Council Member 26 strategic initiatives that were unencumbered and swept into 27 the General Fund Operating Reserves on October 1, 2024. 28 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide grant funds from the City of Jacksonville to MLK Foundation for the 2025 MLK Holiday Grand Parade as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. This will be the 44th year of this event which will be held in downtown Jacksonville on Monday, January 20, 2025. The City funds will offset a portion of the costs of professional fees and services for the Parade event including, but not limited to, equipment and facility rentals, advertising, security, insurance, and post-event cleanup.

Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), 6 Section 3. 7 Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial 8 9 Foundation, Incorporated for coordination of the 2025 MLK Holiday 10 Grand Parade as described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1 11 (General 12 Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted 13 from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are 14 15 to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions 16 17 of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. 18 The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through 19 20 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 21 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with MLK Foundation. This waiver is justified 22 because MLK Foundation has coordinated the MLK Holiday Grand Parade 23 24 and MLK Day festivities in Jacksonville for a number of years. This 25 event honors the memory and legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., 26 one of the most important historical figures of the 20th century. The 27 Parade and MLK Day festivities are held annually as a means to promote 28 and further the ideals and philosophy of this internationally renowned 29 leader.

30 Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is 31 hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation

Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of 1 the City a grant agreement with The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. 2 Memorial Foundation, Incorporated in an amount not-to-exceed \$25,000, 3 subject to the Term Sheet and Budget more particularly described in 4 Exhibit 2, for a term commencing on October 1, 2024 through September 5 30, 2025, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, 6 7 renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject 8 9 to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or 10 his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance 11 with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code. 12

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Office of Sports and
Entertainment shall oversee the project described herein.

15 Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 17 without the Mayor's signature.
