AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; RENAMING A ROADWAY CURRENTLY IDENTIFIED AS "SHIPYARDS PLACE" TO "TOWER COURT" IN COUNCIL 7; DIRECTING THECHIEF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE, ONCE ENACTED, TO THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DIVISIONS, FOR PROCESSING AND COORDINATION WITH 911 EMERGENCY, THEJACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE, AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Addressing Section of the Public Works Department, Development Services Division, received an application to re-name a roadway currently identified as "Shipyards Place", extending between Bay Street East to the St. Johns River in Council District 7, to "Tower Court" and copies of the Application for Street Name Change on a Public Street and the receipt of payment of the application fee are attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2, respectively, and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the proposed street name change to "Tower Court" is to better align the street name to the presence of the newly constructed Four Seasons Hotel located adjacent to the subject roadway; and

WHEREAS, upon this legislation becoming effective, the City will

install a new street sign at the subject roadway to reflect "Tower Court" as the designated street name; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 745.105(i)(6), Ordinance Code, the Addressing Section mailed a notification letter on July 22, 2025, to an affected property owner requesting the property owner to indicate their consent or objection to the proposed street re-naming and a copy of the notification letter is attached as Exhibit 3 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2025, said affected property owner indicated their written consent of the proposed street re-naming, and a copy of the written consent is attached as Exhibit 4 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Community Planning Division, Historic Preservation Section of the Planning and Development Department issued a Memorandum to the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission ("JHPC") indicating the Planning and Development Department had no objection to the proposed re-naming of "Shipyards Place" to "Tower Court" and a copy of said Memorandum is attached hereto as Exhibit 5 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, on August 27, 2025, the JHPC held a public meeting where it considered this matter and voted to approve the re-naming of "Shipyards Place" to "Tower Court" and a copy of the relevant portion of the transcript of said meeting is attached hereto as Exhibit 6 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department, Development Services Division, presented a recommendation to the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee to approve the re-naming of "Shipyards Place" to "Tower Court" and a copy of said presentation is attached hereto as Exhibit 7 and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, on September 3, 2025, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee considered this matter during a public meeting and

voted to accept the staff recommendation to re-name "Shipyards Place" to "Tower Court" and a summary of the minutes of said meeting is attached hereto as **Exhibit 8** and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to subsection 745.105(i)(6), Ordinance Code, the Addressing Section electronically mailed a notification letter on September 11, 2025, to the Downtown Investment Authority ("DIA") requesting the DIA indicate its consent or objection to the proposed street re-naming on behalf of the City of Jacksonville and a copy of the notification letter is attached as Exhibit 9 and incorporated herein by this reference.; and

WHEREAS, on September 17, 2025, the DIA Chief Executive Officer provided written consent of the proposed street re-naming, and a copy of the written consent is attached as **Exhibit 10** and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, based upon the Application, recommendations and comments from Public Works Department staff, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee, Planning and Development Department staff, and the JHPC, the City Council finds it appropriate to re-name "Shipyards Place" to "Tower Court"; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Shipyards Place Renamed as "Tower Court". The roadway currently identified as "Shipyards Place" is hereby re-named to "Tower Court" by which name such street and physical location shall be hereafter known and designated. A copy of the map of Tower Court is attached hereto as Exhibit 11 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Direction to Chief of the Legislative Services

Division. The Chief of the Legislative Services Division is hereby directed to send a copy of this Ordinance, once enacted, to the Public Works Department, Development Services and Traffic Engineering
