ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ΑN MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY"), A FOURTH AMENDMENT TO REDEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN COSENTINO INDUSTRIAL USA, LLC ("COMPANY") AND THE CITY, TO EXTEND CERTAIN TIMES FRAMES WITHIN THE PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE AND EXTEND THE CLOSING DATE FOR THE COMPANY TO PURCHASE THE PROPERTY TO JANUARY 24, 2025; AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE OFFICE OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ("OED"); PROVIDING FOR CITY OF JACKSONVILLE OVERSIGHT BY THE OED; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Cosentino Industrial USA, LLC (the "Company") has previously entered into that certain Redevelopment Agreement dated May 31, 2023 as authorized by Ordinance 2023-310-E, as amended by that certain First Amendment to Redevelopment Agreement dated July 31, 2023, as further amended by that certain Second Amendment to Redevelopment Agreement dated November 27, 2023, as further amended by that certain Third Amendment to Redevelopment Agreement dated July 19, 2024 (collectively, the "Agreement"), to authorize the Company to purchase an approximately 330 acre portion of the City-owned Mega Site within Cecil Commerce Center ("Project Parcel"), and the Company intends to construct thereon as its initial phase of improvements a

408,000 square foot manufacturing facility, with an additional 734,000 square feet of adjacent support area, with two production lines, with an estimated private capital investment of \$270,000,000, and the Company has committed to the creation of 180 new jobs with an average wage of \$56,594 by December 31, 2028 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement contemplated certain wetlands mitigation work to be performed by the City and there were certain delays in the completion thereof that caused delays in the Company's due diligence efforts in relation to the Project Parcel; and

WHEREAS, the Company and the City have agreed to amend the Agreement to (i) extend the closing date on the Project Parcel to on or before January 24, 2025; (ii) extend the commencement of construction date of the improvements by approximately eighteen months to July 1, 2027; and (iv) extend the completion of construction date by approximately three months to March 31, 2030; and

WHEREAS, the Company has requested the City to enter into the Fourth Amendment to Redevelopment Agreement in substantially the form placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Approved. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Fourth Amendment to Redevelopment Agreement (the "Fourth Amendment") substantially in the form placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services (with such "technical" changes as herein authorized), for the purpose of implementing the recommendations of the OED.

The Fourth Amendment may include such additions, deletions, and changes as may be reasonable, necessary, and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by

execution of the Fourth Amendment by the Mayor or her designee. No modification of the Fourth Amendment may increase the financial obligations or the liability of the City and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval of the General Counsel or his or her designee and all other appropriate action required by law. "Technical" is herein defined as including, but not limited to, changes in legal descriptions and surveys, descriptions of infrastructure improvements and/or any road project, ingress and egress, easements and rights of way, performance schedules (provided that no performance schedule may be extended for more than one year without City Council approval), design standards, access and site plans which have no financial impact.

Designation of Authorized Official/OED Contract Section 2. Monitor. The Mayor is designated as the authorized official of the City for the purpose of executing and delivering any contracts and documents and furnishing such information, data and documents for the Fourth Amendment and related documents as may be required and otherwise to act as the authorized official of the City in connection with the Fourth Amendment, and is further authorized to designate one or more other officials of the City to exercise any of the foregoing authorizations and to furnish or cause to be furnished such information and take or cause to be taken such action as may be necessary to enable the City to implement the Fourth Amendment according to its terms. The OED is hereby required to administer and monitor the Fourth Amendment and to handle the City's responsibilities thereunder, including the City's responsibilities under such Fourth Amendment working with and supported by all relevant City departments.

Section 3. Further Authorizations. The Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are hereby authorized to execute the Fourth Amendment and all other contracts and documents

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and otherwise take all necessary action in connection therewith and herewith. The Executive Director of the OED, as contract administrator, is authorized to negotiate and execute all necessary changes and amendments to the Fourth Amendment and other contracts and documents, to effectuate the purposes of this Ordinance, without further Council action, provided such changes and amendments are limited to amendments that are technical in nature (as described in Section 1 hereof), and further provided that all such amendments shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and all other appropriate official action required by law.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Office of Economic Development shall oversee the Project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
