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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2019-2020 fiscal year, City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the within the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

Explanation of Appropriation (C)

The funding above is from Debt Management Fund Loan Proceeds for the construction, contingency, and personnel costs associated with the repair and upgrade of Bridge 724043 on Norman Thagard Boulevard.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to upgrade to current Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) standards the guardrails on Bridge 724043 on Norman Thagard Boulevard and thus provide the driving public with traffic railing that will better prevent errant vehicles from breaking through the railing and crashing into the creek. The asphalt at the approaches to the bridge is damaged and needs to be repaired. The repair items associated with this project constitute safety upgrades and major maintenance to the bridge guardrail and pedestrian barriers.

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Section 3. CIP Amendment. Ordinance 2019-505-E, being the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reduce funding for the project entitled "Countywide Intersection IMP, Brge-Bridges" and provide funding for the project entitled "Norman Thagard Boulevard Bridge Upgrades." The projects are more fully described in the Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such deferral will result in delay repairing critical unnecessary in transportation infrastructure. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of twothirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other

respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
