5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$1,069,280.01 URBAN  
6 SEARCH AND RESCUE GRANT AWARDED BY THE STATE OF  
7 FLORIDA, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT,  
8 THROUGH ITS FISCAL YEAR 2022 URBAN SEARCH AND  
9 RESCUE SUSTAINMENT PROGRAM TO PURCHASE VEHICLES,  
10 CAPITAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES FOR THE URBAN  
11 SEARCH AND RESCUE TASK FORCES, AS INITIATED BY  
12 B.T. 23-021; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY  
13 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT,  
14 EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION; PROVIDING AN  
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2022-2023 fiscal year,  
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of a  
30 \$1,069,280.01 Urban Search and Rescue Grant awarded by the  
31 State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management, through

1 its Fiscal Year 2022 Urban Search and Rescue Sustainment  
2 Program. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD)  
3 will use the funds to purchase vehicles, capital equipment  
4 and supplies for the Urban Search and Rescue Task Forces  
5 (the "Task Forces"). The grant period of performance  
6 commenced July 1, 2022 and ends June 30, 2023. No local  
7 match is required.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
9 Section 1 is to provide grant funding from the State of Florida,  
10 Division of Emergency Management, to procure capital equipment,  
11 supplies and vehicles for the Task Forces including, but not limited  
12 to, an International 4-door Tractor, Command Vehicles (Tahoe or  
13 similar), F350 and F450 Crew Cab Pickup Trucks, Kubota 4 passenger  
14 utility vehicles, Featherlite flatbed dual-axel trailers, a pneumatic  
15 compressor, and field repairable dry suits. This equipment will help  
16 to ensure the Task Forces are maintained in a constant state of  
17 readiness with the ability to immediately respond to any disaster,  
18 whether natural or manmade. Each Task Force must maintain lifesaving  
19 equipment and this grant funding will ensure it is up to date and  
20 complete. A copy of the State-Funded Grant Agreement Urban Search  
21 and Rescue Grant (Agreement Number: T0230) providing the terms and  
22 conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has  
23 been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

24 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
25 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee  
26 administration of the grant described herein.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
29 without the Mayor's signature.
