AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND APPROPRIATING \$1,267,800 FROM THE GENERAL FUND INTERFUND TRANSFER IN ACCOUNT OPERATING -REPRESENTING RETURNED FUNDING RELATED TO TERMINATION OF THE JACKSONVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE 2023-496-E TO PROVIDE THREE MONTH GAP FUNDING FROM JULY 1, 2025 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2025 FOR FOUR CONTRACTS IMPLEMENTING PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES APPROVED BY 2023-807-E AND 2023-847-E, INCLUDING (1) \$375,000 TO TELESCOPE HEALTH, LLC FOR A TELEHEALTH SAFETY NET CLINIC, (2) \$36,000 TO UNITED WAY OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. FOR A 9-8-8 CRISES MENTAL HEALTH CALL CENTER, (3) \$46,800 TO NORTHEAST FLORIDA HEALTHY START COALITION, INC. FOR AN INFANT MORTALITY AND MATERNAL HEALTH INITIATIVE, AND (4) \$810,000 TO URBAN JACKSONVILLE, INC. FOR AN ELDERLY FOOD INSECURITY PROGRAM, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-100; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2023-807-E and Ordinance 2023-847-E appropriated funds to certain of the Mayor's programs and initiatives, and the City entered into certain contracts to implement these programs and initiatives, including (1) Contract between City of Jacksonville and Northeast Florida Healthy Start Coalition, Inc. for Infant Mortality Community Health Workers (City Contract No. 71308-

1 24), (2) Contract between City of Jacksonville and Telescope Health, 2 LLC for Telehealth Safety Net Clinic (City Contract No. 71335-24), 3 (3) Contract between City of Jacksonville and Urban Jacksonville, Inc. for Elderly Food Insecurity Program (City Contract No. 71338-4 5 24), and (4) 2023-2024 City Grant Agreement between City of Jacksonville and United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. for Operation 6 7 of 9-8-8 Crises Mental Health Call Center (City Contract No. 673177-24) (the "Contracts"); and 8 9 WHEREAS, because the respective terms of the Contracts do not align with the City's fiscal year, there is a three month gap in 10 11 funding during the period from July 1, 2025 through September 30, 12 2025; and the City Council therefore desires to appropriate 13 14 funds to cover this gap for the Contracts; now therefore 15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 16 Section 1. 496-E to (1) the Infant Mortality - Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations account (\$46,800), (2) the Telehealth Safety Net/Healthlink Jax - Other Professional Services account (\$375,000), (3) the Elderly Food Insecurity - Other Professional Services account (\$810,000), and (4) the 9-8-8 Crisis Counseling Call Center - Subsidies and Contributions to Private Organizations (\$36,000).

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide three (3) months of funding for each of the following City contracts: (1) \$46,800 to Northeast Florida Healthy Start Coalition, Inc. for an infant mortality and maternal health initiative (City Contract #71308-24), (2) \$375,000 to Telescope Health, LLC for a telehealth safety net clinic (City Contract No. 71335-24), (3) \$810,000 to Urban Jacksonville, Inc. for an elderly food insecurity program (City Contract #71338-24) and (4) \$36,000 to United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. for a 9-8-8 crises mental health call center (City Contract #673177-24).

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.

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
