Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to transfer available revenue in the Downtown Northbank 31

CRA Trust Fund, including \$3,209,498.08 from the Shipyards Office-Iguana Purchase Gain-Loss Sale Other City Property Account, \$347,105.18 from the NB Sports Complex Garage - Reef Parking Tenant Revenue Account, \$67,158.27 from the NB Adams St. Garage - Reef Tenant Revenue Account, \$50,000.00 from the Parking Iquana Investments Gain-Loss Sale Other City Property Account, \$40,282.26 from the NB Courthouse Garage - Tenant Lease Rental of City Facilities Account, and \$10.00 from the Fidelity National Inf./Property Sale Gain-Loss Sale Other City Property Account to the NB Shipyards West CRA Project Other Construction Costs Account. The Project consists of design, permitting and construction of a park and park facilities on the riverfront property known as "Shipyards West". The Project also entails design, permitting and construction of infrastructure and utilities to support restaurant and retail development for a portion of the Shipyards West property. A copy of Resolution 2023-05-02 approving this reallocation of various unappropriated Northbank CRA revenues to the Project, unanimously adopted by the Downtown Investment Authority Board on May 19, 2023, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
