AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE AMENDED AND RESTATED STADIUM LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND JAX STADIUM, LLC ("STADIUM LEASE") REPLACE THE STADIUM LEASE PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE 2024-904-E TO INCORPORATE CHANGES AS REQUESTED BY THE NFL TO CLARIFY SCHEDULING PRIORITY FOR THE FLORIDA-GEORGIA FOOTBALL GAME, CLARIFY THE CITY'S AUDIT RIGHTS UNDER STADIUM LEASE, AND REVISE THE GUARANTY AGREEMENT TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT OF THE JACKSONVILLE JAGUARS, LLC TO PROVIDE EVIDENCE OF ITS FINANCIAL CAPACITY TO FULFILL ITS OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE GUARANTY; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville (the "City") and the Jacksonville Jaguars, LLC ("JJL"), previously negotiated an amended and restated lease agreement ("Stadium Lease") and related documents (the "Stadium Lease Documents") for JJL to renovate, develop and construct on behalf of the City a "Stadium of the Future" and extend the useful life of the Stadium by a minimum of thirty (30) years (the "Facility"), and City Council authorized the Stadium Lease Documents pursuant to Ordinance 2024-904-E;

WHEREAS, subsequent to City Council approval of the Stadium Lease Documents and prior to execution, the NFL raised some concerns

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regarding certain language in the Stadium Lease, and the NFL, JJL and the City have agreed to certain changes thereto reflected in the revised Stadium Lease substantially in the form placed On File with the Legislative Services Division; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Stadium Lease Agreement approved. The Mayor, or her authorized designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an Amended and Restated Stadium Lease Agreement ("Stadium Lease"), revised from the previous version approved by Ordinance 2024-904-E to i) clarify the priority scheduling rights with regard to the annual Florida-Georgia game, ii) clarify the audit rights of the City, and iii) revise the Guaranty Agreement to remove the requirement of JJL to provide evidence of its financial ability to fulfill its obligations under the Guaranty, substantially in the form placed On File with the Legislative Services Division. This Ordinance does not rescind or waive in whole or in part Ordinance 2024-904-E, and all amendments, waivers, requirements, terms, and other conditions of Ordinance 2024-904-E remain in full force and effect and shall govern the Stadium Lease as amended hereby.

The Stadium Lease and Guaranty (the "Agreements") may include such additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or her designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreements by the Mayor or her designee. No modification to the Agreements may increase the financial obligations or the liability to the City and any such modification shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval of the Office of General Counsel and all other appropriate action required by law. "Technical" is herein defined as including, but not limited to, changes in legal descriptions and surveys, descriptions of infrastructure improvements

and/or any road project, ingress and egress, easements and rights of way, design standards, access and site plan, which have no financial 2 3
