# **Conservation Coastal Management Element**

## **Policy 2.12.2**

Duval County's water resources and projected needs through 2025-2034 come from both groundwater and surface water sources. Detailed data regarding water use, projections and sources are included in the background data for this element. JEA shall continue to identify and promote water conservation, alternative water supply sources and other water management strategies, consistent with the St. Johns River Water Management District's (SJRWMD) Regional Water Supply Plan and the provisions of the Potable Water and Natural Groundwater Aquifer Recharge Sub-Elements, in order to meet the City's growing water supply needs.

# **Policy 1.1.13**

The City shall continue to amend the Comprehensive Plan as needed to implement the City's Water Supply Facilities Work Plan (WSFWP) 2018-2028 2024-2034 (Jacksonville Planning and Development Department, February 2019 April 2025), adopted by reference. The WSFWP shall identify those project options from the North Florida Regional Water Supply Plan selected by JEA for implementation. Supporting data and analysis may be attached as appendices to the Water Supply Facilities Work Plan, and updated from time to time, without the necessity of an amendment to the Comprehensive Plan. The City and JEA shall continue to identify and implement traditional and alternative water supply projects and programs, including conservation and water reuse, that are consistent with the SJRWMD's Regional Water Supply Plan to meet the City's water needs.
