Type of Action: Honorary street designation; waiving Section 745.105(i)(2) of the Ordinance Code

Bill Summary: The bill establishes an honorary street designation for a portion of Myrtle Avenue North between 7th Street West and 8th Street West in Council District 8. This section will be designated for, Quenthon Anthony "Nick" Malpress. The bill waives Section 745.105(i)(2) of the Ordinance Code that requires an honoree be deceased for five years before becoming eligible for an honorary street designation. The honoree died in 2018.

Background Information: Mr. Malpress graduated from Stanton High School and was employed by the Jacksonville Housing Authority. He became a coach, referee, and umpire for youth sports in the Duval County Schools and served in those roles for over fifty years, molding the lives of young people through the lessons of honest competition and good sportsmanship. Nick Malpress' sports-related accomplishments were many and varied, from serving on the Jacksonville Jaguars' game-day chain crew, to playing on the U.S. National Senior Softball Team in Panama, to coaching the Edward Waters College women's softball team, to winning awards for his lengthy and outstanding career umpiring and refereeing baseball, softball, football and track & field.

Policy Impact Area: Council District 8 rights-of-way

Fiscal Impact: A private donor has remitted funds to satisfy the cost for the honorary markers in the amount of \$761.
