## ORDINANCE 2024-70

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$66,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY ADMINISTRATION ("NHTSA") FUNDED THROUGH THE FY 23-24 STATE AND COMMUNITY HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY PROGRAM, THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ("FDOT"), TO THE PSBU GRANTS/OCCUPANT PROTECTION PROJECT FY24 INCREASE SAFETY BELT USE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-052; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (THE "CITY") THAT CERTAIN STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) SUBGRANT FOR HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY FUNDS NUMBER G2S39 BETWEEN THE CITY AND FDOT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of grant funds from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration ("NHTSA") funded through the FY 23-24 State and Community Highway Traffic Safety Program, through the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") to the PSBU Grants/Occupant Protection Project FY24 to perform overtime operations to increase safety belt use. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize grant funding to perform High-Visibility Enforcement (HVE) operations in high-frequency crash areas that target occupant protection by increasing safety belt use and will cover expenses for overtime and certain related benefits for law enforcement officers. The term of the grant, and period of performance, shall begin upon the City and FDOT's execution of that certain State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Subgrant for Highway Traffic Safety Funds Number G2S39 between the City and FDOT (the "Grant Agreement"), and shall end on September 30, 2024. The Grant Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions of the grant.

Agreements. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement in substantially the same form as placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services, and any respective extensions or amendments thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Oversight. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office 1 2 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described 3 herein. Section 5. Effective Date.
