Program Background:

The Clara White Mission was founded by Dr. Eartha M. M. White, whose compassion for humanity moved her to action. The Mission has existed for more than 100 years, dedicated to serving the needs of the less fortunate in our community, and after more than a century of service, remains devoted to the humanitarian goals pursued so selflessly by the founder.

The Clara White Mission offers more than meals for the hungry and transitional housing for the homeless. We offer hope and a way out of the misery of a life on the streets. Yes, we provide food and housing, but we also offer vocational programs to put people to work. Our goal is to restore those in need to meaningful, dignified lives in the community.

Program Services and Activities:

Feeding Program The Clara White Mission's "soup kitchen" service provides hot meals to the general homeless population. Volunteers assist with serving daily meals

Payment Terms:

City Funds of up to \$100,000 will be disbursed to the recipient on a reimbursement basis for the following program expenditures.

HVAC repairs and improvements

Kitchen, food preparation and distribution equipment improvements

Additional Grant Requirements and Restrictions:

City Funds for the Program shall be subject to Parts 1, 2, 4 and 5 of Chapter 118, Jacksonville Municipal Code. Recipient shall use the City funds for the Program in accordance with this City Council approved City Grant Proposal Term Sheet.

The Grants Administrator may amend this Term Sheet consistent with the Program needs provided that any substantial change to this Term Sheet will require further Council approval.
