7 A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING CHIEF JAIME
8 EASON OF THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR
9 HER HEROIC ACTIONS AND EXEMPLARY RESPONSE TO A
10 CARDIAC ARREST EMERGENCY, RECOGNIZING HER
11 DEDICATION TO PUBLIC SAFETY; PROVIDING AN
12 EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **WHEREAS,** on December 11, 2024, Chief Jaime Eason of the
15 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office demonstrated extraordinary
16 professionalism, quick thinking, and life-saving actions during a
17 medical emergency involving a sudden cardiac arrest; and

18 **WHEREAS,** while at Aspire Church San Marco, Chief Jaime Eason
19 responded to an urgent situation when a guest speaker collapsed during
20 a church conference. Upon arrival, Chief Eason assessed the scene and
21 began immediate chest compressions to sustain circulation until
22 advanced medical care arrived; and

23 **WHEREAS,** Chief Jaime Eason utilized the church's Automated
24 External Defibrillator to deliver two shocks, effectively restoring
25 the patient's heart rhythm; her swift and effective actions ensured
26 the patient regained a pulse shortly after the arrival of Jacksonville
27 Fire and Rescue Department personnel, significantly improving the
28 patient's chance of survival; and

29 **WHEREAS,** due to Chief Jaime Eason's immediate intervention,
30 the patient experienced an improved likelihood of recovery; and

31 **WHEREAS,** Chief Jaime Eason's ability to remain calm under

1 extreme pressure, her exceptional leadership, and her unwavering
2 commitment to public safety highlight the values and professionalism
3 of the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office; and

4 **WHEREAS**, her actions exemplify the highest standards of
5 collaboration between public safety agencies and underscore the
6 importance of coordinated and timely intervention in saving lives
7 during medical emergencies; now therefore

8 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

9 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby commends Chief Jaime
10 Eason of the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office for her heroic and
11 life-saving actions during a medical emergency, her dedication to the
12 safety of the community, and her exemplary representation of the
13 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office.

14 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
