Upon arrival, Chief Eason assessed the scene and 21 began immediate chest compressions to sustain circulation until 22 advanced medical care arrived; and 23 WHEREAS, Chief Jaime Eason utilized the church's Automated

External Defibrillator to deliver two shocks, effectively restoring the patient's heart rhythm; her swift and effective actions ensured the patient regained a pulse shortly after the arrival of Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department personnel, significantly improving the patient's chance of survival; and

29 WHEREAS, due to Chief Jaime Eason's immediate intervention, 30 the patient experienced an improved likelihood of recovery; and

WHEREAS, Chief Jaime Eason's ability to remain calm under

1 extreme pressure, her exceptional leadership, and her unwavering 2 commitment to public safety highlight the values and professionalism 3 of the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, her actions exemplify the highest standards of collaboration between public safety agencies and underscore the importance of coordinated and timely intervention in saving lives during medical emergencies; now therefore
