RESOLUTION 2024-124-A

A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING MARCH 4-8, 2024, AS CELEBRATE READING WEEK IN JACKSONVILLE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, just 46% of Duval County third graders were proficient at reading in the 2022-23 school year, and research has shown that children who do not learn to read at grade level by the third grade will not be sufficiently prepared when "reading to learn" is required for the rest of their educational journey; and

WHEREAS, children who are not proficient readers by the fourth grade are likely to find up to half of the curriculum at that grade level to be incomprehensible; and

WHEREAS, four out of five students who failed to earn a high school diploma were struggling readers in third grade; and

WHEREAS, the Kids Hope Alliance, the Jacksonville Public Education Fund, WJCT, Jacksonville Public Library, Duval County Public Schools and more than 30 organizations across Jacksonville are aligned in READ JAX, a community effort to improve third grade reading proficiency in Duval County; and

WHEREAS, READ JAX is building infrastructure to promote comprehensive, data-driven services, programming and practices for children and families along the birth-to-third-grade literacy pathway; and

WHEREAS, each year a week-long, community-wide event is held to acknowledge the efforts of partners joined together within READ JAX and to highlight their progress towards improving reading

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1.
