

## Dr. Ellen Glasser

Dr. Ellen Glasser is serving her second term as Mayor of the City of Atlantic Beach. She is a wife, mother and grandmother. Before becoming mayor, she distinguished herself as an FBI Special Agent; as president of a national association of her colleagues; and as a faculty member at UNF.

Dr. Glasser worked in many duty stations during her FBI career, and ended her career in Jacksonville. She played a key role in the Iran-Contra Investigation, along with many high profile bank robbery, terrorism, and violent crime cases. She also was a national press spokesperson and liaison to Congress. After 9/11, she was the inaugural coordinator of the North Florida Joint Terrorism Task Force. After retiring, she was elected as National President of the Society of Special Agents of the FBI.

Following her FBI retirement, Dr. Glasser earned her doctorate in leadership at UNF and taught in the Criminology and Criminal Justice Department for many years. She has been active in community, civic and church activities.
