7 A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL 0385
8 DESIGNATING A PORTION OF U.S. ROUTE 301
9 BETWEEN U.S. ROUTE 90 AND SUMMER FIELD LANE IN
10 DUVAL COUNTY AS "TROOPER EDWIN J. GASQUE
11 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY"; DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF
12 LEGISLATIVE SERVICES TO SEND A COPY OF THIS
13 RESOLUTION TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF
14 TRANSPORTATION, DUVAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION,
15 THE FLORIDA SENATE PRESIDENT AND THE SPEAKER
16 OF THE FLORIDA HOUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
17 DATE.
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19 **WHEREAS**, during the 2019 Legislative Session, the Florida
20 Legislature passed House Bill 0385, which makes honorary
21 designations of transportation facilities through Florida and
22 directs the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to erect
23 suitable markers for those designations; and

24 **WHEREAS**, House Bill 0385 designates that portion of U.S. Route
25 301 (72140000) between U.S. Route 90 and Summer Field Lane in Duval
26 County as "Trooper Edwin J. Gasque Memorial Highway" in Duval
27 County; and

28 **WHEREAS**, Section 334.071, *Florida Statutes*, provides that a
29 city or county must pass a resolution in support of a particular
30 designation before road markers are erected; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the City of Jacksonville wishes to honor Trooper

1 Edwin J. Gasque and requests that the Florida Department of
2 Transportation erect suitable markers designating a portion of U.S.
3 Route 301 (72140000) between U.S. Route 90 and Summer Field Lane in
4 Duval County as "Trooper Edwin J. Gasque Memorial Highway"; now
5 therefore

6 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1.** The City of Jacksonville strongly supports
8 House Bill 0385, and designation of a portion of U.S. Route 301
9 (72140000) between U.S. Route 90 and Summer Field Lane in Duval
10 County as "Trooper Edwin J. Gasque Memorial Highway", and hereby
11 authorizes the erection of appropriate signage by the Florida
12 Department of Transportation to commemorate the designation.

13 **Section 2. Direction to Chief of Legislative Services.**

14 The Chief of Legislative Services for the City Council is hereby
15 directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the Florida
16 Department of Transportation, Duval County Legislative Delegation,
17 Florida Senate President and Speaker of the Florida House.

18 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
19 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
20 without the Mayor's signature.
