7 POLLING PLACE LOCATION FOR PRECINCT 802, A
8 PERMANENT CHANGE IN THE POLLING PLACE LOCATION
9 FOR PRECINCT 1309 AND A TEMPORARY CHANGE IN THE
10 POLLING PLACE LOCATION FOR PRECINCT 307 TO BE
11 EFFECTIVE BEGINNING WITH THE 2024 PRIMARY
12 ELECTION TO BE HELD AUGUST 20, 2024, IN THE CITY
13 OF JACKSONVILLE, DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS
14 REQUESTED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS
15 PURSUANT TO SECTION 352.102, *ORDINANCE CODE*;
16 REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;
17 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

19 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

20 **Section 1. Polling Place Location Change Approved.** At the
21 request of the Supervisor of Elections for Duval County, and pursuant
22 to Section 352.102, *Ordinance Code*, the Council, acting as the
23 governing body for Duval County, hereby approves the permanent polling
24 place location change in precinct 802, the permanent change in the
25 polling place location for precinct 1309 and the temporary change in
26 the polling place location for precinct 307, as listed in **Second**
27 **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled as "Second Revised Exhibit 1, 2nd Rev
28 Notice, June 11, 2024 - Floor" attached hereto, to be effective
29 immediately. The Supervisor of Elections and the Council Secretary
30 are hereby authorized and directed to include this polling place
31 location in the Polling Place List on file in their respective

1 offices.

2 **Section 2. Requesting One-Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
3 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One-cycle emergency passage of this
4 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to ensure
5 that affected voters are notified of the polling location changes
6 prior to the upcoming August 20, 2024 election.

7 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
8 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
9 without the Mayor's signature.
