5 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 380.403 (PROGRAM
6 ESTABLISHED; RULEMAKING AUTHORITY), CHAPTER 380
7 (SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO
8 MODIFY THE APPLICABLE DISTANCES TO FIVE MILES,
9 10 MILES AND 15 MILES FROM THE PROXIMITY TO THE
10 TRAIL RIDGE LANDFILL FACILITY; PROVIDING AN
11 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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13 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1. Amending Section 380.403 (Program Established;**
15 **Rulemaking Authority), Chapter 380 (Solid Waste Management),**
16 **Ordinance Code.** Section 380.403 (Program Established; Rulemaking
17 Authority), Chapter 380 (Solid Waste Management), *Ordinance Code*, is
18 hereby amended to read as follows:

19 **CHAPTER 380. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

21 **PART 4. RESOURCE RECOVERY PROGRAM**

23 **Sec. 380.403. - Program Established; Rulemaking Authority.**

24 * * *

25 There is established a host fee program, hereinafter referred
26 to as the *program*. The program shall be administered by the Solid
27 Waste and Resource Management Department, and the Director of Solid
28 Waste and Resource Management is authorized to adopt, alter, amend
29 and repeal rules for the implementation and administration of the
30 program. The program is divided into three subprograms, as follows:

31 (a) The contamination assessment and remediation program shall be

1 responsible for the implementation of contamination assessment
2 and remediation programs at closed landfill sites.

3 (b) The landfill closure program shall be responsible for the
4 closing of open but filled sanitary landfills.

5 (c) The landfill mitigation programs shall be responsible for
6 benefiting property affected by the landfills by mitigating the
7 effects of such landfills as follows: The Class I landfill
8 mitigation program is applicable to Class I landfills owned by
9 the City. The construction and demolition debris landfill
10 mitigation program is applicable to permitted construction and
11 demolition debris landfills.

12 (i) The Council hereby finds that proximity to a landfill
13 facility is an important factor in determining justifiable
14 usage of mitigation funds, thus it is the intent and desire
15 of the Council that the following allocation formula be
16 utilized on an annual basis as a guideline for utilization
17 and distribution of the mitigation funds available for
18 expenditure during any fiscal year, with all distance
19 measurements to be made from the center of the landfill
20 facility:

21 ~~Forty percent within a four-mile radius of the landfill~~
22 ~~facility; an additional 30 percent within a five-mile radius~~
23 ~~of the landfill facility; and an additional 30 percent~~
24 ~~within a seven-mile radius of the landfill facility; an~~
25 additional thirty percent within 10-mile radius of the
26 landfill facility; and an additional thirty percent within
27 a 15-mile radius. Such distance requirements shall not apply
28 to the funds allocated to Teye' Brown Regional Park pursuant
29 to Section 380.405(b) (1).

31 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become

1 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
2 without the Mayor's signature.
