4 **ORDINANCE 2026-337**

5 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS TANGIBLE
6 PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE;
7 DECLARING THAT CERTAIN 1979 CHEVROLET MALIBU
8 (VIN 1T19L9D483566, VEHICLE NUMBER 0046-10)
9 VALUED AT \$15,000 TO BE SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF
10 THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF TITLE TO
11 SAID VEHICLE TO MOG COLLECTION, LLC D/B/A BRUMOS
12 THE COLLECTION, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH
13 SUBSECTION 122.812(C), *ORDINANCE CODE*; WAIVING
14 SECTION 122.305 (UNLAWFUL USE OF CITY MARKINGS
15 AND TAGS), PART 3 (MUNICIPAL VEHICLES), CHAPTER
16 122 (PUBLIC PROPERTY), *ORDINANCE CODE*, TO ALLOW
17 THAT CERTAIN 1979 CHEVROLET MALIBU (VIN
18 1T19L9D483566, VEHICLE NUMBER 0046-10) TO RETAIN
19 ITS JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE INSIGNIA AFTER
20 TRANSFER FROM THE CITY; DESIGNATING THE FLEET
21 MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF
22 ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES TO MONITOR THE USE OF
23 SAID VEHICLE AFTER TRANSFER; PROVIDING FOR A
24 REVERTER; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR,
25 OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY
26 TO EXECUTE A SURPLUS VEHICLE DONATION AGREEMENT
27 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND MOG
28 COLLECTION, LLC D/B/A THE BRUMOS COLLECTION;
29 REPEALING SECTION 111.396 (MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY
30 PROGRAM FUND), PART 3 (PUBLIC SAFETY AND
31 COURTS), CHAPTER 111 (SPECIAL REVENUE AND TRUST

1 ACCOUNTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*; PROVIDING FOR
2 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE;
3 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office created the "Beat the
6 Heat" Safety and Education program (the "Program") in 1984 to educate
7 youth in Jacksonville about the problems of illegal drug and alcohol
8 use and alcohol or drug impaired driving, to promote a better
9 understanding between the Sheriff's Office and the communities it
10 serves, and to discourage drag racing on the streets of the City; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the primary vehicle used for the Program was a 1979
12 Chevrolet Malibu police vehicle retrofitted as a racetrack certified
13 drag racing car; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office no longer operations
15 the Program and has submitted the vehicle for surplus; and

16 **WHEREAS**, MOG Collection, LLC d/b/a The Brumos Collection
17 (hereinafter, "Brumos") desires to recognize and maintain the
18 educational value of the vehicle by displaying it in a museum operated
19 by Brumos and in other City-approved locations; now therefore

20 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Declaration of Surplus.** The City hereby
22 declares that certain 1979 Chevrolet Malibu (VIN 1T19L9D483566,
23 Vehicle Number 0046-10) valued at \$15,000 as more particularly
24 described in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated
25 herein by this reference (the "Surplus Vehicle"), to be surplus to
26 the needs of the City of Jacksonville and authorizes the appropriate
27 City officials to transfer title to said Surplus Vehicle to Mog
28 Collection, LLC d/b/a The Brumos Collection, at no cost, pursuant to
29 subsection 122.812(c), *Ordinance Code*. A copy of the Certification
30 Declaration of Surplus from the Chief of the Procurement Division
31 certifying compliance with the provisions of Chapter 122, *Ordinance*

1 Code, is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
2 reference.

3 **Section 2. Public Purpose.** The Surplus Vehicle was used by
4 the Jacksonville Sherriff's Office as part of the "Beat the Heat"
5 Program to educate Jacksonville's youth about the dangers of street
6 drag racing. In 1984 a race car engine was installed in the Surplus
7 Vehicle to assist JSO in use of this educational tool in furtherance
8 of the Program.

9 Brumos Racing was one of the sponsors of the vehicle and provided
10 funding for its operation. By donating the Surplus Vehicle to be
11 housed at the Brumos Museum and for display in other professionally
12 organized and reputable car collection and educational venues in
13 Duval County and St. Johns County, the education and safety awareness
14 purposes to which the car was put can continue. The City of
15 Jacksonville finds that transfer of the Surplus Vehicle to MOG
16 Collection, LLC d/b/a Brumos Collection for continued display as an
17 educational tool regarding the dangers of street drag racing is a
18 valid public purpose. For these foregoing reasons and pursuant to
19 subsection 122.812(a), *Ordinance Code*, the public interest supports
20 the disposal of the Surplus Vehicle to Brumos at no cost.

21 **Section 3. Waiver of Section 122.305 (Unlawful use of City**
22 **markings and tags), *Ordinance Code*.** Section 122.305 (Unlawful use
23 of City markings and tags), Part 3 (Municipal Vehicles), Chapter 122
24 (Public Property), *Ordinance Code*, is hereby waived to allow that
25 certain 1979 Chevrolet Malibu (VIN 1T19L9D483566, vehicle number
26 0046-10) to retain its Jacksonville Sheriff's Office insignia and
27 markings so that Brumos may display it as an educational tool in
28 keeping with its purpose as part of the "Beat the Heat" Safety and
29 Education Program.

30 **Section 4. Designating the Fleet Management Division to**
31 **Monitor Use of Surplus Vehicle.** The Fleet Management Division of

1 the Office of Administrative Services is hereby designated to monitor
2 Brumos's display and educational use of the Surplus Vehicle in
3 accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

4 **Section 5. Reverter.** The disposition authorized herein is
5 conditioned upon use of the Surplus Vehicle for the purposes set
6 forth herein and is further conditioned upon Brumos's agreement to
7 convey the Surplus Vehicle back to the City of Jacksonville in the
8 event it is not used for those purposes.

9 **Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute Agreement.**
10 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the
11 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute for and on
12 behalf of the City, a Surplus Vehicle Donation Agreement between the
13 City of Jacksonville and the MOG Collection, LLC, d/b/a Brumos
14 Collection, in substantially the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**
15 and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Agreement"), setting
16 forth additional terms and conditions relative to Brumos's receipt
17 and use of the Surplus Vehicle as authorized herein.

18 **Section 7. Repealing Section 111.396 (Motor Vehicle Safety**
19 **Program Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts), Chapter 111 (Special**
20 **Revenue and Trust Accounts), Ordinance Code.** Section 111.396 (Motor
21 Vehicle Safety Program Fund), Part 3 (Public Safety and Courts),
22 Chapter 111 (Special Revenue And Trust Accounts), *Ordinance Code*, is
23 hereby repealed in its entirety. A copy of the repealed Section
24 111.396 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 4.**

25 **Section 8. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
26 shall have oversight of the Agreement described herein.

27 **Section 9. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
29 without the Mayor's signature.
