The funding above represents an appropriation of \$890,395.15 from the Florida Department of Health to fund the Central Health Plaza Upgrades Project.

5 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 6 Section 1 is to appropriate funds from the Florida Department of 7 Health to pay for costs of maintenance and renovations to the Central Health Plaza Building located at 515 West 6th Street, Jacksonville. 8 9 The building is currently occupied by the Florida Department of Health 10 and is in need of maintenance and renovations. Improvements include, but are not limited to, painting and flooring replacement. The Florida 11 Department of Health has agreed to transfer the \$890,395.15 to the 12 City of Jacksonville to cover the costs of the Project which will 13 have no cost to the City. Construction of the Project shall not 14 commence until the City has received the funds from the Florida 15 Department of Health for the Project. The Project is in Council 16 District 7. 17

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 18 19 2023-505-E, adopting the 2024-2028 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 20 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is 21 hereby amended to reflect the appropriation of funds to the Project, 22 as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP 23 Sheet, March 18, 2024 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this 24 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment 25 26 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 27 28 deferral will unnecessarily delay completion of these necessary 29 repairs and upgrades to the Central Health Plaza Building.

6 Section 4. Oversight. The Public Buildings Division of the 7 Department of Public Works shall oversee the Project described herein.

8 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 9 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 10 without the Mayor's signature.
