RE: Lenox Square to Tiphne D Hollis Lane - Road Renaming

DATE: March 26, 2025

Consistent with Chapter 745 of the Jacksonville Ordinance Code on addressing and street naming regulations, requests to rename streets require a review and recommendation from the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission. In making a report and recommendation, the Commission shall address the following criteria:

1. The origin of the street name
2. Any historical significance of the existing street name
3. Whether there are any historical structures or landmarks on the subject street
4. Whether the existing name is part of a common theme of street names throughout the community where such street is located
5. The age of the street name
6. Whether the street name is a duplicate street name

Current Street Name: Lenox Square

Proposed Street Name: Tiphne D Hollis Lane

Reason for Change:

The name change seeks to honor the life and legacy of the late Tiphne Darshay Hollis.

Analysis:

The origin of Lenox Square could not be determined by Staff. The earliest usage of Lenox Square can be found in the Department's Zoning Atlas maps (Panel 212) recorded in 1971.

The request for the name change applies to the entire portion of Lenox Square, as depicted in the location map below.

No historic structures or landmarks have been identified along this portion of the subject street. However, the existing road name is part of a common theme of street names in the area with Lenox Avenue running east to west.

Recommendation:

At the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission (JHPC) on March 26, 2025, the Planning Department had no objections to the proposed street name change from Lenox Square to Tiphne D Hollis Lane, based on the best evidence available. **JHPC voted 5-0 to approve the name change.**
