7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE
8 AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00 FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA
9 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY FLORIDA
10 DEFENSE INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH THE
11 FLORIDA DEFENSE SUPPORT TASK FORCE ("FDSTF") AND
12 ADMINISTERED BY ENTERPRISE FLORIDA, INC., TO
13 SUPPORT THE CITY'S ENCROACHMENT
14 PROTECTION/COMPATIBLE LAND USE PROGRAM FOR THE
15 PURCHASE OF RESTRICTIVE USE EASEMENTS ON
16 PROPERTIES WITHIN THE MILITARY INFLUENCE ZONE
17 SURROUNDING DUVAL COUNTY NAVAL BASES AND
18 AIRFIELDS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 22-096;
19 APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS
20 DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO
21 EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
22 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND ENTERPRISE FLORIDA,
23 INC. FOR THE FLORIDA DEFENSE SUPPORT TASK FORCE;
24 PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE MILITARY AFFAIRS
25 AND VETERANS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
26 DATE.

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28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
30 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
31 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)

9 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

10 The funding above is a grant from the State of Florida
11 Department of Economic Opportunity through the Florida
12 Defense Support Task Force ("FDSTF") and administered by
13 Enterprise Florida, Inc. These funds will be used to
14 support the City's Encroachment Protection/Compatible
15 Land Use Program for the procurement of restrictive use
16 easements on properties within the Military Influence Zone
17 surrounding Naval bases and airfields in Duval County. The
18 grant period commences on July 1, 2022 and continues
19 through June 30, 2023. No local match is required.

20 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
21 Section 1 is to allocate grant funds from the State of Florida
22 Department of Economic Opportunity through FDSTF for the City's
23 Encroachment Protection/Compatible Land Use Program (the "Program").
24 The Program was established in partnership with the United States
25 Department of the Navy to protect naval bases and airfields in Duval
26 County from encroachment by incompatible land uses and development
27 within the Military Influence Zones through the procurement of
28 restrictive use easements. These grant funds will be utilized along
29 with funding from the Department of Defense in furtherance of the
30 Program's objective by purchasing additional restrictive use
31 easements on properties surrounding NS Mayort, NAS Jacksonville and

1 OLF Whitehouse. These easements are acquired from willing sellers
2 to secure Duval County's Navy bases and airfields from encroachment
3 and to minimize community concerns regarding aircraft traffic and
4 noise.

5 **Section 3. Approval and Authorization.** There is hereby
6 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
7 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on
8 behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement between the City of
9 Jacksonville and Enterprise Florida, Inc. for the Florida Defense
10 Support Task Force, a copy of which has been placed **On File** with the
11 Office of Legislative Services.

12 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Military Affairs and Veterans
13 Department shall oversee administration of the grant described
14 herein.

15 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
17 without the Mayor's signature.
