AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00 FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY DEFENSE INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH THE FLORIDA DEFENSE SUPPORT TASK FORCE ("FDSTF") AND ADMINISTERED BY ENTERPRISE FLORIDA, INC., TO SUPPORT THE CITY'S ENCROACHMENT PROTECTION/COMPATIBLE LAND USE PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF RESTRICTIVE USE EASEMENTS ON PROPERTIES WITHIN THE MILITARY INFLUENCE ZONE SURROUNDING DUVAL COUNTY NAVAL BASES AND AIRFIELDS, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 22-096; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND ENTERPRISE FLORIDA, INC. FOR THE FLORIDA DEFENSE SUPPORT TASK FORCE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE MILITARY AFFAIRS AND VETERANS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(c) Explanation of Appropriation

The funding above is a grant from the State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity through the Florida Defense Support Task Force ("FDSTF") and administered by Enterprise Florida, Inc. These funds will be used to support the City's Encroachment Protection/Compatiable Land Use Program for the procurement of restrictive use easements on properties within the Military Influence Zone surrounding Naval bases and airfields in Duval County. The grant period commences on July 1, 2022 and continues through June 30, 2023. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to allocate grant funds from the State of Florida Department of Economic Opportunity through FDSTF for the City's Encroachment Protection/Compatible Land Use Program (the "Program"). The Program was established in partnership with the United States Department of the Navy to protect naval bases and airfields in Duval County from encroachment by incompatible land uses and development within the Military Influence Zones through the procurement of restrictive use easements. These grant funds will be utilized along with funding from the Department of Defense in furtherance of the Program's objective by purchasing additional restrictive use easements on properties surrounding NS Mayort, NAS Jacksonville and

OLF Whitehouse. These easements are acquired from willing sellers to secure Duval County's Navy bases and airfields from encroachment and to minimize community concerns regarding aircraft traffic and noise.

Section 3. Approval and Authorization. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Enterprise Florida, Inc. for the Florida Defense Support Task Force, a copy of which has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 4. Oversight. The Military Affairs and Veterans Department shall oversee administration of the grant described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
