Mitchell began 11 WHEREAS, Gretchen her career with the Jacksonville Public Library in 1990 as a librarian at the Webb 12 Wesconnett Regional Branch, and over the course of 35 years, has 13 demonstrated unwavering dedication to library services and the 14 15 citizens of Jacksonville; and

20 WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell most recently served as Deputy Chief 21 Librarian for Support Services, a role she assumed in May 2018 after 22 previously holding the position of Assistant Director for Support 23 Services from 2009 to 2018; and

WHEREAS, throughout her tenure, Ms. Mitchell provided executive oversight of critical areas including facilities, safety and security, finance collection management, and technology services across the library system; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell collaborated with the Florida State College at Jacksonville (FSCJ) to lead a major initiative to offer hotspots and laptops to students through library locations, helping document the effort in the publication *Fostering Student Success*: 1 Academic, Social and Financial Initiatives; and

2 WHEREAS, during Ms. Mitchell tenure as Administrative 3 Supervisor from 2003 to 2009, she was responsible for the operations 4 of seven library branches and later the Main Library, overseeing 5 branch renovations and the construction of new facilities under the 6 Better Jacksonville Plan; and

7 WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell has been a committed mentor and leader 8 within the Sunshine State Library Leadership Institute, serving five 9 times as a mentor since 2005 and participating in the Library's 10 mentoring managers program; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Mitchell was honored as the Jacksonville Public Library's Employee of the Quarter in the third quarter of 2008-2009, a testament to her leadership, mentorship, and professional excellence; and
