AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,000 FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESIGNATED CONTINGENCY TO THE GENERAL FUND - GENERAL SERVICES DISTRICT SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO PRIVATE ORG ACCOUNT TO PROVIDE A GRANT TO REVITALIZE ARLINGTON, INC., FOR THE ENGAGE ARLINGTON PROGRAM (THE "PROGRAM") AS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO DECEMBER 31, 2024; PROVIDING FOR REVERTER OF FUNDS; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH REVITALIZE ARLINGTON, INC.; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH REVITALIZE ARLINGTON, INC.; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND REVITALIZE ARLINGTON, INC. FOR THE PROGRAM; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACT COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$15,000 from the Council President's Designated Contingency to the General Fund - General Services District Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account to provide a grant to Revitalize Arlington, Inc. ("Recipient" or "Revitalize Arlington") for the Engage Arlington Program (the "Program").

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding from the City of Jacksonville to the Recipient for the Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The Program will include introduction of a new healthy food and nutrition service through which meal-kits and nutrition coaching will be provided for up to 36 to 40 residents over a period of three months. The intent is to provide information and guidance regarding healthy cooking and personal/family nutrition for residents in the Arlington area. In addition to this new nutrition initiative, City funds will be used

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to engage a facilitator who will provide two workforce and financial literacy education events where attendees will learn about responsible financial and economic practices and career readiness.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to December 31, 2024.

Section 4. Reverter. Any funds remaining after completion of the project described herein shall be returned to the account of origin by January 31, 2025.

Section 5. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of Revitalize Arlington, Inc. to administer the Program described herein. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Part 1 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with Revitalize Arlington, Inc. This waiver is justified because the Recipient has maintained a long-standing presence in the Arlington community including by offering food pantry services. Revitalize Arlington, Inc. is therefore well suited to develop and implement a program that targets the specific needs of the community.

Section 7. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation

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Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City a grant agreement with Revitalize Arlington, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$15,000, subject to the Term Sheet and Budget more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing on August 1, 2024 through November 30, 2024, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 8. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
