Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, 16 17 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) 18 19 listed in subsection (b): (The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and 20 21 incorporated herein by this reference) 22 (a) Appropriated from: 23 See Exhibit 1 \$577,514 24 (b) Appropriated to: See Exhibit 1 25 \$577,514 26 Explanation of Appropriation: (C) 27 The funding above represents an appropriation of funds from 2.8 the Florida Department of Law Enforcement ("FDLE") through 29 a single, non-recurring appropriation in The General Appropriations Act, 2024 Legislature, Section 4, Specific 30 Appropriation 1290, Grants and Aids - Special Projects, to 31

the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO") to be used for the purchase of a Mobile Command Vehicle ("MCV"). The grant period commenced on July 1, 2024 and continues through June 30, 2025, subject to any extensions that may requested by JSO and approved by FDLE. No local match is required.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to utilize funds from FDLE to purchase a Mobile Command Vehicle for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO"). The MCV will significantly improve JSO's ability to respond to critical incidents and to conduct investigations. The MCV will provide detectives with a versatile on-scene command center with additional resources and equipment, allowing them to be more efficient and effective in the field. A copy of the Award Agreement outlining the terms and conditions relative to receipt and use of funds from FDLE as described herein is attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3. Oversight. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee administration of the agreement and project described herein.

Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that there is a significant lead time to procure the MCV which must be completed during grant term ending on June 30, 2025.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
