Bill Summary: This bill authorizes a Cooperative Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and Clay County for Medical Examiner Services and Reimbursement. The Medical Examiner will review the fees annually no later than June of each year and if fees do not cover the services rendered then Clay County will be provided with a ninety (90) day notice of any increase in fees. The Medical Examiner's Office Operations Manager, currently Tim Crutchfield, will provide oversight of the contract/agreement.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to address the reimbursement of Medical Examiner's fees for autopsy services performed for Clay County. The District IV Medical Examiner was been appointed by the Florida Governor to serve the three county area of Nassau, Clay, and Duval Counties. Duval County has allocated the annual salary for the Medical Examiner's Office and Clay County will reimburse Duval County for the value of the District IV Medical Examiner's autopsy services it receives. The reimbursement reflects the fees as defined by Ordinance 2017-0370-E and will be in effect for three years from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023.

Policy Impact Area: District IV Medical Examiner services and reimbursement

Fiscal Impact: The impact of not providing this service is an estimated loss of more than \$700,000 in revenue.
