AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 1.77± ACRES, 5 LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2 AT 0 ATLANTIC 6 7 BOULEVARD N., BETWEEN ABESS ROAD EXTENSION AND 8 MARKETPLACE DRIVE (PORTION OF R.E. NO(S). 9 167445-0215), AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY PROPERTY MANAGEMENT SUPPORT, INC. AS TRUSTEE OF 10 ATLANTIC NORTH LAND TRUST, FROM PLANNED UNIT 11 (PUD) DISTRICT (2018-701-E) 12 DEVELOPMENT ТО 13 PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT (PUD) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE, TO 14 15 PERMIT OUTDOOR STORAGE OF NEW VEHICLES FOR SALE, AS DESCRIBED IN THE KERNAN WEST AUTO PARK PUD, 16 PURSUANT TO FUTURE LAND USE MAP SERIES (FLUMS) 17 18 SMALL-SCALE AMENDMENT APPLICATION NUMBER L-5997-24C; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER 19 THAT THE 20 REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED 21 AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; 22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

24 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville adopted a Small-Scale 25 Amendment to the 2045 Comprehensive Plan for the purpose of revising 26 portions of the Future Land Use Map series (FLUMs) in order to ensure 27 the accuracy and internal consistency of the plan, pursuant to 28 companion application L-5997-24C; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure consistency of zoning district with the 2045 Comprehensive Plan and the adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment L-5997-24C, an application to rezone and reclassify from Planned Unit Development (PUD) District (2018-701-E) to Planned Unit Development (PUD) District was filed by Michael Herzberg, on behalf of the owners of approximately 1.77± acres of certain real property in Council District 2, as more particularly described in Section 1; and

6 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department, in order to 7 ensure consistency of this zoning district with the 2045 Comprehensive 8 Plan, has considered the rezoning and has rendered an advisory 9 opinion; and

10 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has considered the 11 application and has rendered an advisory opinion; and

12 WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning Committee, after due notice 13 and public hearing, has made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, after due notice, held a public hearing, and taking into consideration the above recommendations as well as all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning is consistent with the 2045 Comprehensive Plan adopted under the comprehensive planning ordinance for future development of the City of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the proposed PUD does not 20 21 affect adversely the orderly development of the City as embodied in the Zoning Code; will not affect adversely the health and safety of 22 residents in the area; will not be detrimental to the natural 23 24 environment or to the use or development of the adjacent properties 25 in the general neighborhood; and the proposed PUD will accomplish the objectives and meet the standards of Section 656.340 (Planned Unit 26 27 Development) of the Zoning Code of the City of Jacksonville; now 28 therefore

29 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: 30 Section 1. Subject Property Location and Description. The 31 approximately 1.77± acres are located in Council District 2 at 0

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Atlantic Boulevard N., between Abess Road Extension and Marketplace Drive (portion of R.E. No(s). 167445-0215), as more particularly described in **Exhibit 1**, dated November 1, 2024, and graphically depicted in **Exhibit 2**, both of which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (the "Subject Property").

Section 2. Owner and Applicant Description. The Subject
Property is owned by Property Management Support, Inc. as Trustee of
Atlantic North Land Trust. The applicant is Michael Herzberg, 12483
Aladdin Road, Jacksonville, Florida, 32223; (904) 731-8806.

Property Rezoned. 10 Section 3. The Subject Property, pursuant to adopted companion Small-Scale Amendment Application 11 L-5997-24C, is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Planned Unit 12 Development (PUD) District (2018-701-E) to Planned Unit Development 13 14 (PUD) District. This new PUD district shall generally permit outdoor storage of new vehicles for sale, and is described, shown and subject 15 to the following documents, attached hereto: 16

18 **Exhibit 2** - Subject Property per P&DD.

19 Exhibit 3 - Written Description dated October 12, 2024.

20 Exhibit 4 - Site Plan dated September 26, 2024.

21 Section 4. Contingency. This rezoning shall not become 22 effective until thirty-one (31) days after adoption of the companion 23 Small-Scale Amendment; and further provided that if the companion 24 Small-Scale Amendment is challenged by the state land planning agency, 25 this rezoning shall not become effective until the state land planning 26 agency or the Administration Commission issues a final order 27 determining the companion Small-Scale Amendment is in compliance with 28 Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.

Section 5. Disclaimer. The rezoning granted herein shall <u>not</u> be construed as an exemption from any other applicable local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or

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approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or 1 2 approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development 3 or use and issuance of this rezoning is based upon acknowledgement, representation and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), 4 5 developer(s) and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject business, development and/or use will be operated in strict 6 7 compliance with all laws. Issuance of this rezoning does **<u>not</u>** approve, 8 promote or condone any practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal, state or local laws. 9

Section 6. Effective Date. The enactment of this Ordinance shall be deemed to constitute a quasi-judicial action of the City Council and shall become effective upon signature by the Council President and the Council Secretary.
