Type of Action: Appointment Confirmation with Retroactive Effective Date

Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Sheriff's appointment of Nick Burgos as Director of Investigations and Homeland Security, within the Sheriff's Office, providing a retroactive appointment and confirmation.

Background Information: Section 37.109, *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Director of the Department of Investigations and Homeland Security, within the Office of the Sheriff, shall have a college degree or at least five years' training and experience.

Chief Burgos has been employed with the Sheriff's Office since 1996, working his way up from Patrol Officer to Police Chief of Patrol in 2017. He received a Bachelor's of Science in Criminal Justice Administration from Mountain State University in Virginia.

Policy Impact Area: Jacksonville Sheriff's Office operations

Fiscal Impact: According to Human Resources, the salary range for this position is \$109,600 - \$178,939 annually.
