Bill Type and Number: Ordinance 2025-66

Type of Action: Appropriation, authorization of positions, and designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$107,112 in grant funding from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to fund the Monitoring Demonstration Study program for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. The grant period is June 1, 2024 – May 31, 2025. The bill approves the two new full-time positions within the Environmental Quality Division. The Environmental Quality Division within the Neighborhood Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for air pollution monitoring functions within Duval County. The appropriation will cover the salary expenses for an environmental specialist and environmental scientist supervisor.

Policy Impact Area: Environmental Quality program

Fiscal Impact: Appropriation of \$107,112, no City match required
