AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$146,630.20 IN GRANT 5 FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT 6 7 AGENCY FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION 8 GRANT PROGRAM, THROUGH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, 9 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ("FDEM"), TO FUND THE ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 4629 10 WRICO DRIVE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32209 (RE# 11 040445-0000) AND THE DEMOLITION 12 OF THE 13 RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE LOCATED THEREON, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-027; APPROVING AND 14 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE 15 CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, 16 FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE 17 (THE "CITY"), THAT CERTAIN FEDERALLY-FUNDED 18 19 SUBAWARD AND GRANT AGREEMENT NUMBER H1110 20 BETWEEN THE CITY AND FDEM; AMENDING THE 2025-21 2029 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED 22 BY ORDINANCE 2024-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT ENTITLED "ACQUISITION AND DEMO OF A 23 FLOODPRONE PROPERTY - WRICO DRIVE"; PROVIDING 24 25 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS 26 DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 27

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:
Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,
within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

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10 The funding above represents a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program ("HMGP") award in the amount of \$146,630.20 from 11 the Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") through 12 the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management 13 ("FDEM"), for completion of the hazard mitigation project 14 described in this Ordinance. There is a 25% 15 match requirement to be provided by the City for this hazard 16 17 mitigation project.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 18 Section 1 is to fund the acquisition of that certain property located 19 20 at 4629 Wrico Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32209 (RE# 040445-0000) 21 (the "Property"), and to fund the demolition of the private 22 residential structure located thereon, including removal of 23 foundation slabs and debris on the Property, as approved by FDEM and 24 FEMA in accordance with the HMGP (the "Project"). Upon completion of 25 the Project, the Property will be converted to green space and will 26 become subject to a perpetual open space conservation easement, in 27 accordance with FEMA requirements. All activities associated with the 28 Project shall be completed in strict compliance with federal, state, 29 and local rules and regulations. The term of the grant, and period 30 of performance, shall begin upon the City and FDEM's execution of that certain Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement Number 31

H1110 (the "Grant Agreement") and shall end on August 31, 2027.

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2 Section 3. and Authorization Approval to Execute 3 Agreements. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and 4 5 deliver, for and on behalf of the City, the Grant Agreement in substantially the same form as placed **On File** with the Office of 6 7 Legislative Services, and any respective extensions or amendments 8 thereto as necessary and appropriate to effectuate the intent of this 9 Ordinance.

10 Section 4. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 2024-505-E, adopting the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 11 12 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to reflect this appropriation of funds to the project 13 entitled "Acquisition and Demo of a Floodprone Property - Wrico 14 Drive." This project is more fully described in the Project 15 Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein 16 17 by this reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will 18 19 be detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 20 deferral will unnecessarily delay urgently-needed mitigation of this 21 floodprone Property and the safe removal of residents from the 22 immediate dangers of flooding. The Property is located in an area 23 that is subject to persistent nuisance flooding and the Project will 24 reduce future costs to the county, state, and federal agencies that 25 provide evacuation and rescue, emergency shelter, and debris removal 26 services in the area.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2024-505-E. In all other respects, the

3	Section 5. Oversight. The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue
4	Department, Emergency Preparedness Division, shall oversee Project,
5	including administration of the Grant Agreement, as described herein.
6	Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
7	effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
8	without the Mayor's signature.
