Add provision stating closure is contingent upon acquisition of certain City-owned property by the applicant. 2. Authorize execution of an air rights easement over Albert Street closure area. 3. Attach Revised Exhibit 2 (Hold Harmless Covenant) to include revised legal descriptions and boundary survey sketches. 5.
