AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$200,000 FROM A
GENERAL FUND OPERATING ECONOMIC GRANT PROGRAM
MISCELLANEOUS-NON DEPARTMENTAL EXPENDITURES
ACCOUNT TO THE OFFICE OF SPORTS AND
ENTERTAINMENT SEA AND SKY - MISCELLANEOUS
SERVICES AND CHARGES ACCOUNT, TO PROVIDE FUNDS
FOR THE 2025 SEA AND SKY SPECTACULAR EVENT AS
INITIATED BY B.T. 25-042; PROVIDING FOR
CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING
FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF SPORTS AND
ENTERTAINMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$200,000 from a General Fund Operating Economic Grant Program Miscellaneous-Non Departmental Expenditures account to the Office of Sports and Entertainment Sea and Sky - Miscellaneous Services and Charges account to provide funds for the 2025 Sea and Sky Spectacular event.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide City funds for the 2025 Sea and Sky Spectacular airshow event.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2025-2026.

Section 4. Oversight. The Office of Sports and Entertainment shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
