

Business Impact Estimate

SHEFFIELD REGIONAL PARK; AMENDING THE 2026-2030 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE 2025-505-E TO REFLECT THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE PROJECT ENTITLED “PARKS QOL-WILLIAM SHEFFIELD REGIONAL PARK” AND THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO THE PROJECTS ENTITLED “ED AUSTIN PARK-PICKLEBALL COURTS AND LIGHTS”, “ED AUSTIN PARK-SPORTS LIGHTING” AND “SHEFFIELD PARK-SPORTS LIGHTING”; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE .
