Type of Action: Approve renewal of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CON)

Bill Summary: This bill approves the application of GFL Solid Waste Southeast LLC for renewal of its CON to operate a construction and demolition debris processing and recycling facility with a modification to operate the facility as a construction and demolition debris and yard trash transfer station and a clean debris recycling facility.

Background Information: GFL Solid Waste Southeast LLC has applied for renewal of its CON for the continued operation of a construction and demolition debris processing and recycling facility with a modification to operate the facility as a construction and demolition debris and yard trash transfer station and a clean debris recycling facility, located at 11011 Blasius Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32226. The CON was initially granted by Ordinance 2009-845-E, modified by Ordinance 2011-375-E, renewed by Ordinance 2015-406-E, modified and renewed by Ordinance 2016-307-E, and thereafter administratively renewed by the Director of the Department of Public Works.

Based upon the determination of need for the facility by the City Council, the Solid Waste Division of the Office of Administrative Services supports approval of the application for renewal and modification of the CON, if GFL Solid Waste LLC agrees to accept and comply with the Specific Operating Conditions listed in Exhibit 1 to this bill.

Policy Impact Area: Waste disposal, Public Works

Fiscal Impact: No cost to the City.
