If House Bill 653 became law and it is determined to apply to Jacksonville, JEA would no longer be allowed to contribute to the City General Fund from the electric system. Under the current agreement, this would create a hole in the budget of approximately \$94 million per year. It could impact the current fiscal year as its effective date is July 1, 2020.
