Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 31

Section 1 above is to allocate the remaining balance of sales proceeds from Load King Manufacturing Company's ("Load King") purchase of City property to the New Town Success Zone Park at Edward Waters University project. Ordinance 2019-135-E authorizing the sale of the City property to Load King provided that \$162,000 of the sales proceeds would be deposited into a designated account for Council District 9 within the Jacksonville Recreational and Environmental Acquisition fund as the property was located in then Council District 9. However, since the completion of the most recent redistricting process in 2023, the City property purchased by Load King is now located in Council District 7. As such, in keeping with the intent of Ordinance 2019-135-E, the Council desires to allocate the remaining sales proceeds from the sale of the City property to the Edward Waters University New Town Success Zone Park project in District 7 to ensure the funds are used to maintain a park in the District near the location of the property purchased by Load King.

Section 3. Oversight. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall have oversight of the project described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
