Type of Action: Appointment confirmation and one cycle emergency passage

Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Cultural Council's appointment of Suzanne Pickett to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, replacing Tim Snyder, as one of the three board members, for a first full-term expiring December 31, 2027. One cycle emergency passage is requested to align with the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee's orientation which is currently scheduled for Wednesday, June 4, 2025.

Background Information: The Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is established pursuant to Chapter 118, Part 6, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to recommend to the Cultural Council Board of Directors the organizations to be funded through the Cultural Service Grant Program and the allocation of the lump sum appropriation to applicant organizations.

Section 118.605(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee is composed of one non-voting and ten voting members: a CSGP Committee chairperson (non-voting), appointed by the President of the Cultural Council Board of Directors; three other Cultural Council Board members selected by the Board President and Committee Chairperson; and seven individuals selected by the above group (Cultural Council Board President, CSGP Committee chairperson, and three selected Cultural Council Board members), confirmed by the City Council.

Ms. Pickett holds a bachelor's degree from the University of North Florida. She is the co-founder and Executive Director of Historic Eastside Community Development Corporation, co-founder of The Art Center Cooperative and the Director of Housing, Wealth Building and Community Development for the Jacksonville Urban League.
